Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Develop models of existing overhead electrical and communication facilities utilizing various line design and pole loading software such as PLS-CADD and O-Calc
- Work with field personnel to collect data needed for modeling overhead electrical and communication facilities.
- Assist in evaluating feasibility of adding additional communication facilities to the existing infrastructure meeting utility and NESC/GO-95 code requirements while minimizing impact on existing facilities.
- Assist field personnel in laying out new underground communication facilities.

- Bachelor of Science in Engineering (Civil, Mechanical or Electrical) from an accredited ABET. university/college is required; Power engineering emphasis is preferred.
- Engineer in Training (EIT/FE) preferred and desire to work towards obtaining PE license is required.

- Distribution overhead line design and construction experience is preferred.
- PLS-CADD, PLS-POLE modeling experience is preferred.

- Strong organizational and project coordination abilities are required.
- Must be authorized to work in the U.S.
